





# PAPER CATS | INSTRUCTIONS




## Before you start:


A **valley fold** means that you are creating a valley shape as you fold.

A **mountain fold** means that you are folding away from you to create a “peak”.




1. Taking your square piece of paper with the printed side facing away from you, **valley fold** it in half along the diagonal line.

2. Still with the printed side facing away from you, use the crease as a guide to **valley fold** the left and right corners to meet the centre line.


3. **Valley fold** the bottom corner **(A)** to the top corner **(B)**.  
(41 secs)

4. **Valley fold** the left and right corners in so that the edges meet the triangular shape.  
(55 secs)




5. Unfold the large triangle **(A)** then fold the top corner **(B)** down so that the point meets the horizontal edge, using the line on the printed side as a guide.  
(1 min 17 secs)

6. One at a time, **valley fold** the right edge to meet the horizontal crease as shown in **(A)** then repeat with the left edge **(B)**. Make sharp creases along the **diagonal creases** shown in the diagram.


7. Using both hands, push in the **valley folds** you have just made at the same time, pushing inwards in the direction of the marked arrows. As you do this, a triangular shape will form, shaping the face of your origami cat. Adjusting slightly, carefully make sure that everything lays flat as you reinforce the fold.


8. To make the cat ears, **valley fold** the top layer flaps on the left and right hand sides in the direction of the arrows shown above and unfold once the creases have been made.


9. Lift the first layer of the cat's face, from the **bottom edge** (marked in red) using your index finger. With your other hand, push the left ear from the left most point inwards and under the cat's face. Repeat for the opposite ear.


10. Next, lift the right half of the cat's face and ear over to the left side.




11. Using the marked **crease line**, **valley fold** diagonally where indicated.




12. Your paper should look as above. Now rotate 180 degrees.




13. To finish forming the ears, **valley fold** and **mountain fold** where indicated (it may be useful to look at the next two diagrams to help understand how the ears are created).




14. As you make these folds, a flap will start to open. Carefully press this flap to flatten it into the shape of the pointed ear.




15. The first ear should look like this. Now repeat from step 11 on the other side.


16. Start by pushing the flaps all the way to the other side. Making a diagonal crease, **valley fold** and **mountain fold** where indicated.



17. Again, you should see a flap starting to open. Carefully press this flap to flatten it into the shape of the pointed ear. Well done, the cat's face is now complete!


18. **Mountain fold** the entire cat along the centre.


19. Diagonally **valley fold** down the tail to form a crease. You can use this crease line as a guide but you can adjust this crease depending on how big you want your cat's body to be.

For a longer body, make the crease closer to the tail, or for a smaller body, fold the crease closer to the head.



20. Open up the tail a little and push the paper inwards, **mountain folding** along the creases that you've just made. The tail folds should fold in on itself and point downwards as illustrated above.


21. Now pull the tail up and fold along the horizontal line so it is pointing up.  (4 mins 53 secs)



22. Take the **cat's left leg** (there will be two flaps) **valley fold** the whole leg along its **vertical crease line**, pushing the cat's head down and forwards as you do so. You can fold the right leg if you want your cat's head to be facing the opposite way.  (5 mins 13 secs)



23. As you do this, the head will start to stick up. Being as careful as you can, push the head down so that it lies a little more flat. Finish your cat by tucking up the chin.  (5 mins 41 secs)








2. **Valley fold** both top corners to the centre.

3. With the corner you've just folded, **valley fold** along the **crease lines**, making sure to fold from the **corner points**. Align the bottom edge to the diagonal, make a crease and unfold. Now align the side edge to the diagonal edge, make a crease and unfold.





4. Once the creases are sharp, unfold this panel in the direction of the arrow.




8. Repeat steps 3-7 on the left side. Once your paper resembles the diagram above, flip your paper over so the Pikkii logo is now face up.

9. With your sheet now turned over, next create a **valley fold** from **corner to corner** on both sides as shown by the marked crease line on the diagram.






17. Repeat this diagonal fold on the other side, pushing the head back and reinforcing the **face fold**. Align the ears as you do so. You should now be able to recognise your paper pup from a side profile.  5 mins




18. To create the tail, **valley fold** the tip upwards to make a sharp crease. Unfold the crease just made. The next step will involve folding the crease back on itself.  5 mins 40 secs



19. Opening the layers from the direction of the **arrow**, refold the crease back on itself so it becomes a **mountain fold**, to make the tail point up.  5 mins 46 secs



1. Taking your sheet of paper with **Pikkii logo side up**, check the printed dog face is on the top edge on the reverse. Now **valley fold** your sheet of paper in half both vertically and horizontally




2. **Valley fold** your paper in half diagonally in both directions, making sharp folds as you do so.



3. Take the right edge and make a fold line along the marked **crease line** by aligning it with the **diagonal crease** just made. Now fold the bottom edge to the same diagonal line to make a sharp crease.

4. Now create fold lines in the same way as step 3 but on the opposite side. **Valley fold** the bottom edge to **diagonal crease (in bold)** followed by the left edge, aligning with the diagonal each time.




5. **Valley fold** in each corner to the centre and unfold to a square sheet again.


6. Starting with the bottom edges, fold them up to the marked **intersection points**, following the direction of the corresponding arrows. Do the same with the left and right edges, folding them up to the marked **intersection points**.




**7. Valley folding** the corners to the centre again, fold the creases made in step 4 into **mountain folds** to create a point as shown above. Repeat on the left side.






**9. Repeat these **valley folds** on the left side, aligning the edges to the diagonal before creasing.**




**10. Now, one side at a time, follow the creases you just made, starting from the **corners points** marked with the **crosses**. As you do so, it will create a triangle flaps. Your paper should look as per the diagram above.**




**11. Now **fold** your paper in half along the vertical line.** ⌚ 10 mins 32 secs



**12. Starting with the top layer, begin to **valley fold** the top edge to the vertical crease, following the **fold line** marked from the top corner. Create the crease and unfold again.**





13. Now **valley-fold** the right edge (top layer only) to the vertical crease, following the **fold line** from the bottom corner to make a sharp crease. From the folds just made, look for the **triangle shape** formed by the creases. Rotate your paper 90 degrees.




14. Now following along the creases you've just made and starting from the **corner points**, create the **triangle shape** and flatten down to enforce the creases. Your paper should look like the diagram above, with the two triangles pointing down to form the legs of your paper pup. Repeat steps 10 to 12 on the flip side.


15. The smaller triangle tab poking out will form the ear. Opening up from the direction of the arrow, **valley fold** the horizontal edge to align with the edge of the leg and flatten to make a crease. This will reveal the pup's eye.


16. Flip your paper and fold the second ear as per step 13 to resemble the illustration above.


17. To create the face, step fold along the **crease lines**, **mountain folding** along the first crease and then **valley folding** along the second.


18. Opening up from the direction of the arrow, fold the creases back on themselves to make the dog's muzzle. Now **fold the tip** of the nose and tuck up underneath.


19. Use the same process to make the tail, step-folding along the **crease lines**, **mountain folding** along the first line and **valley folding** along the second. Open up from the top to reverse the folds and allow the tail to poke out. You can tuck in the tail once more to make a flat tip if you prefer.


20. Following the crease lines illustrated above, first **mountain fold** the front leg (in the direction of the tail) and then **valley fold** forward along the second marked **crease line** to form the little paws. Do the same on the other side to make the second front paw.


21. **Mountain-fold** the tip of each of the back legs so they point forwards and the feet are level. Adjust the creases on the face, tail and feet until you are happy with how your paper pup looks and it stands upright.


1. Taking your printed piece of paper, **Pikkii logo side up**, as shown above, **valley fold** it in half along the diagonal line to make a crease. 18 mins 3 secs

2. **Valley fold** the top edge to the crease line just made. Now fold the side edge to diagonal crease line. 18 mins 21 secs





3. Using a **valley fold**, fold each edge to the centre as marked with the dotted lines above. 18 mins 50 secs

4. **Valley fold** each edge to centre once again, following the **crease lines** as illustrated. Now flip your sheet over. 19 mins 15 secs



5. Taking the bottom point, **valley fold** to the top point and then **mountain fold** along the second dotted-line shown on the diagram. Don't worry if the lines on your paper pup don't line up exactly at this stage. Now flip your paper over once more. 19 mins 46 secs




6. Taking the top point, fold it down the intersection point marked with an **X**.





7. Following the **crease lines, mountain fold** the edges back to shape the dog's face.

9. **Valley-fold** the very top point **A** down along the line shown above. This will shape the tip of the dog's nose. Next, pull out the bottom fold by pulling the bottom point **B**. ⌚ 21 mins 26 secs




10. **Valley fold** in half along the vertical line so it looks like above.



11. Rotate the paper 90 degrees to resemble the diagram. Now, make a **valley fold** along the crease line in the diagram, push the head back along this crease by opening up slightly from beneath.







14. **Valley fold** along the crease line shown above. Now open up from the direction marked with an arrow and lift the point of the tail upwards, going back against the crease just made. This will form the paw and tail of the dachshund.  23 mins 3 secs







3. With the corner you've just folded, **valley fold** along the **crease lines**, making sure to fold from the **corner points**. Align the bottom edge to the diagonal, make a crease and unfold. Now align the side edge to the diagonal edge, make a crease and unfold.

4. Now folding along both the creases just made, create a **mountain fold** along the crease illustrated in the diagram to pinch the corner to a point.


8. From the corner marked with a **cross**, create a fold along the **crease line** by **valley folding** the left edge down to the horizontal edge. 27 mins 14 secs




9. Create a second crease from the opposite **corner**, again, aligning the (right) side edge to the bottom horizontal edge, ensuring the folds are sharp. 27 mins 21 secs



10. Like in step 5 create a pinching motion to bring the corner to a point by folding along the crease lines just made. Look at the next step to see how it should look. 27 mins 30 secs



11. Repeat steps 7-11 on the opposite side, following the **valley folds** and pinching to a point. 27 mins 40 secs




12. Now **valley fold** the sheet in half along the **horizontal crease line** illustrated above. 28 mins 25 secs




13. With your paper now folded in half, fold the top layer down along **horizontal crease line**. 28 mins 30 secs

14. Flip the paper over and **valley fold** the top layer on this side down as per the previous step.




15. Now pull out right tab **(A)** that is tucked behind (as marked by the arrow) undoing the crease so it resembles the diagram **(B)** above.







17. Now working with the first layer, **valley fold** from the right point (**marked with a cross**) to create a sharp diagonal crease that will reveal the dog's face.





19. Take your paper, and hold it by the middle triangle tabs from either side. From the top view, pull open (**in the direction of the arrows**) from the middle tabs you are holding.



20. Still holding the middle tabs and with the paper now opened up, push the **central vertical crease** to one side so it resembles the diagram above. 30 mins 43 secs




21. Holding the middle tabs from each side again, now begin to **valley fold** your paper in half along the horizontal line. Start to pinch inwards as you fold it closed along the **vertical** as well.  30 mins 47 secs



22. As you pinch in, aim to make an "L" shape like the diagram above. The tabs you were holding will form the front legs.  31 mins 25 secs




23. Now for the detail. Look out for the corner tab (**marked by the arrow**) on either side of the pup's front legs. Push this corner in on both sides, just so that it is hidden by the front legs.  31 mins 26 secs




24. Open up the layers under the tail section to reveal the inside. The next steps will involve forming the tiny tail that pokes out from the pup's body.  32 mins 9 secs


25. Taking the bottom point (**marked with a cross**), pull it up so it **valley folds** along the **vertical** and the middle triangle tabs point downwards to make the pups' back legs. Next, **mountain fold** the pointed section down along the marked **crease line**.  32 mins 20 secs




26. Again, taking the bottom point (**marked with a cross**), **valley fold** it up along the **crease lines** to make the tiny tail point up. 32 mins 39 secs



27. Now you are ready to **valley fold** the paper pup closed again along the vertical crease line, allowing the little tail to poke out. 32 mins 50 secs




28. From the side, your paper pup should resemble the diagram with the face pointing up.




29. To shape the hind legs, **mountain fold** the back corners to tuck them in. Do this on both legs and adjust the folds until the legs look how you want.


30. Now it is time to form your paper pup's head. Start by opening up the layers from beneath the chin. When you see the **central fold**, push it over to one side.

31. Opening up fully from this angle, begin to **valley fold** head down along the horizontal crease line. At this point, you will need to fold along the **vertical crease** to make the head face forwards.





32. The pup's head should now be facing forward. **Valley fold** the ears on either side forward creating a crease from the point at the pup's crown and making a **diagonal fold**.



33. Flatten out the ear by opening up between the layers, **A** in the direction of the arrow and fold the ear to the left to make the shape shown in the diagram **B**.

34. To shape the ears, **mountain fold** at the crown and tuck in. You can do the same on the bottom and back corners of the ears as illustrated above. Repeat this process (step 33 & 34) on the opposite ear.

35. Opening from under the chin, **mountain fold** at the edge of the printed face on your paper pup and tuck the point under to form the dog's muzzle. Finally, reinforce any folds to straighten up your pup until you're happy with how it looks and it stands upright. And there you have! Another paper pup. Well done for hanging in there because this was a tough one.



1. Taking your sheet of paper with the **Pikkii logo side up**, fold the left corner to the right and open again. Then fold the top corner to the bottom corner to make **crease lines** as shown above. 37 mins 40 secs

2. **Valley fold** your paper along the diagonal crease lines shown above, folding the opposite sides, edge to edge and reinforcing the folds.


11. Repeat this fold on the left side, ensuring sharp creases have been made, aligning point 1 with point 2 as you make the fold.



12. Folding along both **valley folds** you just made, pinch from the underside of the **vertical** crease to bring the top corner to point upwards.




13. Fold this section to the side. Now flip the whole thing over.




14. Your paper should now resemble the illustration above. Next, **valley fold** along the horizontal crease line, bringing point **(A)** to point **(B)**.


15. Now **valley fold** this section to the left so the point of the dog's face is pointing upwards.




16. Keeping the head section pointing up, **mountain fold** the paper in half along the crease line shown in the diagram. This will create the body and legs of your paper pup.




17. Fold the face along the **crease line** in both directions to reinforce a sharp crease.




18. Open from the direction of the arrow and, using two fingers, push the pup's head back on the creases just made.  40 mins 32 secs




19. Now all that remains is to shape the face and tail of your paper pup. Create a **mountain fold**, followed by a **valley fold** to create a step that will make the puppy's muzzle.  40 mins 44 secs




20. Next, **mountain fold** along the crease at the crown to shape the puppy's head. You can tuck in the corner at the dog's mouth if you prefer here too. 41 mins 21 secs




21. To make the tail, fold the left point **(A)** down the back paw **(B)**. Now **valley fold** the end of the tail up**(C)**. 41 mins 41 secs



22. Opening up from underneath, make the first crease into a **mountain fold** and the second into a **valley fold**, revealing the tip of the tail. 41 mins 48 secs



23. Finally, tuck in the back point to form the dog's butt. And there you have it, another paper pup to add to your collection! 42 mins 9 secs
