


The easiest and best way to assemble your Bigfoot is by watching the video. Use the QR code below, or the link beneath if the code does not work.

Bigfoot Assembly Instructions



Tools Needed: Phillips head screw driver, 3/8 inch wrench or pliers.

Arrange your Bigfoot face-down on a flat surface, as shown. A thin blanket or sheet will keep it and the table from being scratched. One hole on each piece is marked with a label and letter matching the hole on the body. The words OVER and UNDER let you know what order to screw the pieces together. Fasten the screws only finger-tight until all the screws are in, then tighten them with a screwdriver. You should slip the screws underneath, then fasten the nut on the top or back of the Bigfoot.

Start with the letter "A," and "B," then pivot the legs towards the middle and insert a screw through all three sheets of metal at "C." Then you repeat with the other lettered holes by matching up the letters and pivoting the pieces to align with the other holes. Once you have all the screws in, it helps to stand it up to tighten with a screw drive and wrench or pliers. Remember to put the screws in from the front with the labels that are marked "UNDER."

It seems complicated, but the video makes it very easy to assemble.

Use the many brackets on the back to secure it to a tree, post, fence or wall with wire or rope. Finally, it is secured to the ground with the two 10-inch stakes provided. If theft is an issue, the stakes can be anchored in post hole cement.
